

# WELCOME to ESSEX COUNTY INDOOR BOWLS SECTION.

## 1. Dress code

### **General**

- a) every player on the bowling green shall wear heel-less flat soled bowls shoes
- b) white plain polo shirts/ **Club** polo shirts (bearing the official Club emblem)/blouses to be worn above the waist
- c) **Competition** shirts (*as registered with EIBA*) are worn for Indoor National, County competitions as the rules permit, but may be worn anytime Outdoor unless advised otherwise.
- d) Hats/caps if worn, must be white.
- e) regulation plain trousers/skirts/culottes/cut-offs shall be mid-grey for all play except for matches as directed on the selection sheet.
- f) white belts shall be worn with white trousers and grey belts with grey trousers.
- g) Sandals or open-toed footwear are **NOT** allowed on the green.
- h) Tailored shorts may be worn Outdoors

### **Men specific**

- a) formal Club dress (*Club shirt with grey trousers – blazer optional*) will be worn at the after match meal and on any other occasion as directed.
- b) braces if worn, must be white and not be visible.

### **Ladies - specific**

- a) formal Club dress (*Club shirt/ white top with collar and sleeves, grey trousers/ culottes/ cut-offs or skirt and Club red waistcoats*) will be worn at the after match meal and on any other occasion as directed.
